I am glad to inform you that the Council of Ministers, in the meeting on the 7th inst., approved the participation of the Thai Delegation in the Fifth Far East Agricultural Credit and Cooperative Workshop to be held in Secul, Republic of Korea, from May 10 to 26, 1965. In this regard, I wrote to Dr. Nam Kyu Chung, General Secretary of the Workshop Preparatory Committee, a letter dated April 8, 1965, a copy of which is enclosed herewith.

It was also approved, in principle, by the Council of Ministers that Thailand would accept to be a host country for the Sixth Far East Agricultural Credit and Cooperative Workshop to be held in 1967.

The three Thai delegates, out of seven, whose international traveling and living expenses are to be borne by USAID/Thailand, are Mr. Chern Bamroongwongse, Chief Cooperative Inspector, Department of Credit and Marketing Cooperatives, Mr. Prayard Chandrapuang, Chief, Agricultural Economics Research and Farm Survey Section, Ministry of Agriculture, and Mr. Kangwan Devahastin, Economist, Office of the National Economic Development Board.

As regards the date of arrival in Seoul of the Thai delegates and USAID advisors, I would suggest, for convenience, that all of us should arrive in the same date, i.e., May 7th or in the morning of May 8th and, if possible, by the same airline.
